

# KOBRAS 2018 – INFO FOR EVENT

Players **must** identify the events that they want to enter. To play in a particular age group players **must** have been under the age specified for their competition group on 1st January.

All tournaments will be handicapped and players may be allocated to novice groups for their age based upon the information provided on their application forms and at the organiser's discretion.

The format of the singles and doubles competitions is open which means that boys and girls will play against each other and in the Doubles pairs can be Boys, Girls or Mixed. Competitions for different age groups will be played on the dates set out in the table above. Timings of quarter finals, semi-finals and finals are dependent on the completion of other matches.

The rally point scoring system will be used in all competitions. Each match will be one game to 21 points and no setting . All matches will be stopped briefly to announce the start of competition finals.

The entry fee is £10 per player per event. A stamped, self-addressed envelope or email address **must** be provided so that the organiser can send confirmation of acceptance of entry to the Tournament. Names of confirmed entrants will be posted on the Bradford Kobras Performance Centre web site (web address to be confirmed, Google Bradford Kobras Performance Centre or email [ashley.reed@bdat-academies.org](mailto:ashley.reed@bdat-academies.org)). Competition numbers are strictly limited and prospective players will be entered into events on a first come first served basis.

Players **must** arrive at least 15 minutes before their event starts and ensure that they report to the Registration Desk before entering the playing areas. Failure to arrive on time or be ready to start matches promptly may result in expulsion from the event or conceding of matches at the discretion of the Tournament organiser. Also, any entry fees paid will not be refunded. As in previous years, sandwiches, snacks and light refreshments will be available from an approved vendor.

If you have any health problems that affect your ability to play badminton please indicate this on your entry form and contact the organiser directly to discuss these and your capability to play. Medical supplies for minor injuries, e.g. plasters and ice packs, will be available to players and/or their parents/guardians at the Registration Desk, for application by them and it is anticipated that a registered first aider will be present on each day of the tournament. Photographs of players and their supporters will be taken at the Tournament and may be used to promote future tournaments and the Bradford Kobras Performance Centre. Photography and video recording of the Tournament is prohibited other than by those approved directly by the Tournament organiser, the Bradford Kobras Performance Centre.

The Bradford Kobras Performance Centre and its representatives cannot be held responsible for personal injury, loss or damage to equipment.

## To Enter

To enter, you, or your parent/guardian if you are under 16 years old, **must** complete and sign an entry form (see over) and send it with your entry fee to Ashley Reed (for address see front of leaflet).

All fees **must** be received in advance of the Tournament. Entry applications will not be accepted until an entry fee is received for each event entered and providing competition spaces are available.
